This will give us scope to bring them together for fun activities, followed by corporate worship and explore the Bible in smaller and larger groups. There will be opportunity to develop the youth as followers of Jesus giving them ownership of their own journey as we enable youth to practise and refine their giftings.

This will be gathering the church youth as family.

The numbers of our children (Connect 7-11s – Awakening) are growing as we reach out to the community around us. And we see that we will need to move all Connect over to Vineyard House on a Sunday morning.

This enables us to intentionally think about the way we create a special place for our children through games, virtual reality, interactive activities, and visual stimulus to help children engage with Jesus, their faith, prayer, the Bible and each other. We want to develop them as worshippers and provide opportunity for them to explore what that might look like.

Using pool, table tennis, air hockey, board games, creativity, and reflection, we look forward to building deeper relationships amongst our children, and giving them a full experience of church family. This is a key age as children will choose whether to follow Jesus later in life or not.
